The BlackBerry Storm2 smartphone features the innovative SurePress™ touch screen that supports both user interactivity and a crisp, clear visual experience. It's designed for people who place equal importance on mobile entertainment technology (streaming, music, etc.) and mobile communication technology (email, Internet, etc.). The SurePress touch screen on the BlackBerry Storm2 comes with a few enhancements that make the interaction between user and device more natural, comfortable and non-tiring. These enhancements include:

- convenience keys which are now integrated into the SurePress touch screen
- greater consistency with tactile response across whole screen

Here are some tips when using the SurePress™ Touch Screen:

Highlighting and Selecting

- To select an item, click (press) the item.
- To highlight an item or to place the cursor, touch the screen lightly.
- To hide the keyboard, slide your finger down.


Scrolling

- To scroll down, slide your finger up.
To move down a screen, slide your finger up quickly.
- To scroll up, slide your finger down.
To move up a screen, slide your finger down quickly




Moving between items

- To move to the next item, slide your finger to the left quickly.
- To move to the previous item, slide your finger to the right quickly.

Zooming and Panning

- To zoom in to a picture or web page, touch the screen twice quickly. To zoom out from a picture or web page, press the  key.
- To pan a picture, slide your finger in any direction.

Other Navigation tips:


- To open a menu in any application to access options and available actions, press the  key.
- To close a menu or move back a screen, press the  key.
- To lock the screen or device, press the **Lock** key.

Powering your BlackBerry smartphone On and Off

- If you have not set your BlackBerry® smartphone to turn on and turn off automatically at specific times, hold the  key.
- If you have set your BlackBerry smartphone to turn on and turn off automatically at specific times, in the application screen, click **Turn Power Off**.
- If you want the BlackBerry smartphone to turn on again at the specified time or for alarm or calendar reminders, click **Turn Off**.

OTA Instructions for your device

1. Perform the usual billing system activation procedure.
2. Power-up the phone and enter Star Code, *228 [Send].
3. The following audio message will be heard: *“Welcome to Verizon Wireless’ device programming . This call is airtime free. To program your phone, press 1. Update your roaming capabilities, 2, to switch devices and use your same mobile number, 3.”*

Note: Programming will take up to 2 minutes. Should the programming exceed 45 seconds, the following audio message will be repeated at 25 second intervals: *“Please continue to hold. Your phone is being programmed.”* You will hear an audio message once the phone has been successfully programmed.

Manual Activation Instructions

1. Enter phone application – one time dial ##000000 and press the **Send** key. (This will open the “**CDMA Service Edit Screen**”)
2. In the first field, “**Mobile Directory Number**”, delete the default entry and enter the **MDN**.
3. In the second field, “**IMSI_S**”, delete the default entry and enter the **MIN**.
4. Scroll to the bottom of the “**CDMA Service Edit Screen**”.
5. Verify SIP login information is correct.
Login: **MDN@vzw3g.com**
Password: **vzw**
6. Click the BlackBerry key to display **Menu**.
7. Select and click **Save**.
8. Device will save information and reboot.

Manual programming is now complete.

Battery Hints.... Try performing the following actions:

- Set your BlackBerry® device to turn on and turn off automatically.
- Charge your device regularly.
- Keep your battery connections clean. Every few months, use a cotton swab or dry cloth to clean the metal contacts on the battery and the device.
- Set backlighting to remain on for a shorter period of time and lower its brightness.
- Turn off the connection to the wireless network when you are not in a wireless coverage area.
- Switch your vibrating notifications to sound or LED notifications, lower the volume of your sound notifications, or select a shorter ring tone.
- Delete the original message when you send a reply.
- Send a message to multiple contacts using Add To, Add Cc, or Add Bcc.
- Turn off the flash in the camera.
- Close third-party applications from the application menu when you are finished with them.
- Change your browser options for animated graphics so that they repeat less often on web pages.

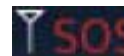

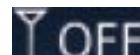

The BlackBerry smartphone is equipped with an integrated earpiece and microphone. You can place and answer phone calls from your smartphone.

Make a call



1. On the Home screen or in the phone application, perform one of the following actions:

- Type a phone number. To call an international number, type +, then the country code, then the area code, then the phone number. For example: + 44 1206 123 4567 could be used to call a number in the United Kingdom from the United States or abroad.
- Click the **Contacts** icon. Highlight a contact or phone number.


2. Press the  key.

To end the call, press the  key.

Answering a call

Press the  key. To end the call, press the  key.

Send an SMS Text message

1. In a message list, press the  key.

2. Click **Compose SMS Text**.

3. In the **To** field, perform one of the following actions:

- Type an email address.
- Type an SMS phone number. If you are outside the U.S., enter the contact's phone number as if you were calling it. (Include "+" or exit code and country code).
- Type a contact name.
- Type part of a contact name. Click a contact.


4. Type a message.

5. Press the  key.

6. Click **Send**.

Visit a Web page

1. In the browser, perform one of the following actions:

- If a web address field appears on the screen, type a web address.
- If a web address field does not appear on the screen, press the  key. Click **Go To**. Type a web address.


2. Press the **Enter** key.

Zoom in to or out from a web page

On a web page, touch the screen twice quickly.


To zoom out, press the **Escape** key.

Move back or forward a web page

1. On a web page, press the **Menu**  key.

2. Click **Back** or **Forward**.


Schedule an appointment

1. In a calendar, press the  key.

2. Click **New**.

3. Type the appointment information.

4. If the appointment recurs, change the **Recurrence** field.

5. Press the  key.

6. Click **Save**.

Delete an appointment or meeting

1: In the Calendar, highlight an appointment or meeting.

2: Press the  key.

3: Click **Delete**.

Take a picture

1. In the camera, if necessary, perform the following actions:

- To zoom in to or out from a subject, slide your finger up or down.
- To lock the focus on a subject, press the **Right Convenience** key halfway.

2. To take a picture, click the **camera** icon.

Note: The approximate number of pictures that you can save to the device memory or the media card appears in the lower-left corner of the screen.

Pan a picture


To perform this task, you must zoom in to the picture. On a picture, slide your finger in any direction. To close the picture, press the **Escape** key once in the camera or twice in the media application.

Zoom in to or out from a picture

On a picture, touch the screen twice quickly. To zoom out, press the **Escape** key.

Change the picture size

The larger the picture, the more memory the picture requires.

1. In the camera, press the **Menu**  key.
2. Click **Options**.
3. Change the **Picture Size** field.
4. Press the **Menu** key.
5. Click **Save**.

Record a video

1. In the video camera, click the **record** icon.
2. To pause recording, click the **pause** icon again.

Note: The approximate amount of memory available for saving videos to the device memory or the media card appears in the lower-left corner of the screen.

Change the video size and format

The larger the video, the more memory the video requires.

1. In the video camera, press the **Menu** key.
2. Click **Options**.
3. Change the **Video Format** field.
4. Press the **Menu** key.
5. Click **Save**.

Change the location for storing pictures or videos

1. In the camera or video camera, press the **Menu** key.
2. Click **Options**.
3. Perform any of the following actions:
 - In the camera, change the **Store Pictures** and **Folder** fields.
 - In the video camera, change the **Folder** field.
4. Press the **Menu** key.
5. Click **Save**.

About Picture and Video (MMS) Messaging

You can send and receive MMS messages on the BlackBerry Storm2. If you have more than one phone number associated with your BlackBerry® smartphone, your device sends MMS messages using the first phone number that appears in the drop-down list at the top of the phone screen.




You can add pictures that are not copyright protected to an MMS message, but the message cannot exceed 300 KB.

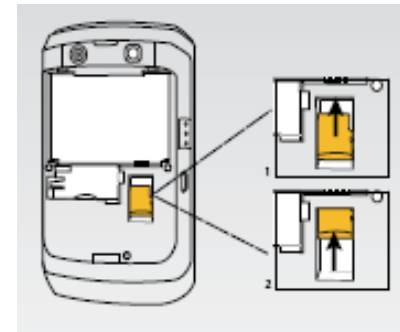

 - If the contact is not in your address book, click **[Use Once]**. Click **Email** or **Phone**. Type an email address or an MMS phone number. If you are outside the U.S., enter the contact's phone number as if you were calling it. (Include "+" or exit code and country code).Press the  key.
 - If the contact is in your address book, click a contact. Click an email address or MMS phone number.
4. Type a message.
5. Press the  key.
6. Click **Send**.

Memory Card

The BlackBerry Storm2 comes with an 16GB microSD memory card installed. It supports memory cards up to 16GB. The microSD media card is used to extend the memory available on your BlackBerry® smartphone for storing your media files such as songs, ringtones, videos or pictures. Should you choose to insert memory cards of other capacities, please follow these simple instructions:

To insert the media card

- 1: Lift off the battery cover using the notch at the bottom of the bottom of your BlackBerry smartphone.
 - 2: Hold the microSD card so that the metal contacts on the microSD card face down and point toward the top of your BlackBerry smartphone.
 - 3: Slide the microSD card into the microSD card slot until it stops.
- To remove the microSD card, pull the microSD card down using the notch at the bottom of the memory card.

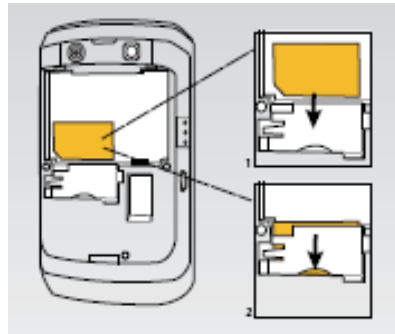

Installing the SIM card

Your BlackBerry smartphone comes with an installed SIM card but should your SIM card be lost or damaged, these are the instructions for the re-installation of the SIM card:

- 1: Lift off the battery cover using the notch at the bottom of the BlackBerry smartphone.
- 2: Using the notch at the top left corner of the battery compartment, pull the battery out.
- 3: Remove the SIM card from any packaging.

- 6: Re-insert the battery so that the metal contacts on the battery align with the metal contacts on your BlackBerry smartphone.

- 8: Push down the battery cover so that it clicks into place.

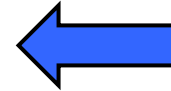
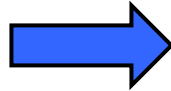
